Text of NY Minimum Wage Bill Finalized

The <u>text</u> of the New York legislature's <u>proposed minimum wage increase</u> confirms increases as previously reported:

- \$8.00 on and after December 31, 2013
- \$8.75 on and after December 31, 2014
- \cdot \$9.00 on and after December, 2015.

Per the language of the amendment, the minimum wage requirements for food service workers and other tipped employees remains unchanged, pending any change to the <u>Wage Orders governing such</u> <u>employees promulgated by the Department of Labor</u>. Employers should plan for these proposed increases, and monitor this space for further legislative developments.
